

**ARCHDIOCESE OF BIRMINGHAM
PARISH BOUNDARIES
SAINT BERNADETTE, WOMBOURNE, STAFFS**

Interpretation of Boundaries:

1. A house or institution belongs to the parish holding the road or side of the road into which opens its principal entrance.
2. A cul-de-sac, crescent, etc., having official opening(s) only onto one road belongs to the parish holding the road or side of the road having such official opening(s), unless the contrary be expressly stated.
3. The boundary always follows the middle of roads, lanes, footpaths, rivers, etc., unless stated otherwise.

Starting in the north at the junction of the Bridgnorth Road (A 454) with the Lane leading to Ebstree, near Trescott:

1. South along the EBSTREE LANE to the Road to Lower Penn (both sides);
2. South-east along the LOWER PENN ROAD to Ebstree Road (both sides);
3. East along EBSTREE ROAD to Market Lane (both sides);
4. South along MARKET LANE, crossing Spring Hill, and continuing along DENE LANE to Orton Lane (both sides);
5. South-east along ORTON LANE to Billy Buns Lane (both sides);
6. East along BILLY BUNS LANE to the Stourbridge Road (both sides);
7. Crossing the Stourbridge Road and continuing east along GOSPEL END ROAD to the junction at Gospel End with Fir Street (both sides);
8. South along FIR STREET to the grounds of Baggeridge Colliery (neither side);
9. South along the WESTERN BOUNDARY OF BAGGERIDGE COLLIERY to the Mineral Railway line emerging from the grounds to the south (all colliery grounds excluded);
10. South along the MINERAL RAILWAY LINE through White's Wood and under the Himley Road to Oak Lane, near Ham Lane;
11. West along OAK LANE and its continuation HOLBEACHE LANE to Wolverhampton Road;
12. North for a few yards along WOLVERHAMPTON ROAD to the Brook;
13. West along the BROOK to the Worcester Canal near Hinksford Pumping Station;
14. South along the WORCESTER CANAL to Greensforge Road;
15. North-west along GREENSFORGE ROAD, across the Swindon/Enville Road and along the ROAD BY CAMP FARM and HIGHGATE COMMON, taking the RIGHT FORK AT GOSPEL ASH and continuing to the Diocesan Boundary at Halfpenny Green;
16. North along the DIOCESAN BOUNDARY to the Bridgnorth Road near Shipley;
17. North-east along the BRIDGNORTH/WOLVERHAMPTON ROAD (A 454) to the junction near Trescott with the Lane to Ebstree.
