

**ARCHDIOCESE OF BIRMINGHAM
PARISH BOUNDARIES
ST THOMAS OF CANTERBURY, TETTENHALL, WEST MIDLANDS**

Interpretation of Boundaries:

1. A house or institution belongs to the parish holding the road or side of the road into which opens its principal entrance.
2. A cul-de-sac, crescent, etc., having official opening(s) only onto one road belongs to the parish holding the road or side of the road having such official opening(s), unless the contrary be expressly stated.
3. The boundary always follows the middle of roads, lanes, footpaths, rivers, etc., unless stated otherwise.

Starting in the north at the junction of the Shropshire Union Canal with Ballard's Brook, near Barnhurst Lane:

1. South-east along the SHROPSHIRE UNION CANAL to the Staffordshire and Worcestershire Canal at Autherley Junction;
2. South along the STAFFORDSHIRE AND WORCESTERSHIRE CANAL across Tettenhall Road to Compton Road West;
3. West along COMPTON ROAD WEST and its continuation BRIDGNORTH ROAD to the Diocesan Boundary near Shipley
4. North along the DIOCESAN BOUNDARY to the Shifnal Road near Boningale Park;
5. East along the SHIFNAL ROAD (A 464) to the Old Road passing Kingswood Bank Farm
6. South-east along the OLD ROAD past Kingswood Bank Farm, Simmond's Wood, Bradshaw's Farm and continuing along the LANE past Cranmoor Lodge to Wrottesley Park Road;
7. South along WROTTESELEY PARK ROAD, passing west of the Perton Estate, to Perton Road at Perton;
8. East along PERTON ROAD to Mill Lane (both sides)
9. North along MILL LANE and YEW TREE LANE to Wergs Road (both sides, thus including specifically Wrottesley Road West and Westcroft Road);
10. West along WERGS ROAD / HOLYHEAD ROAD (A 41) to Ballard's Brook near Werg Hall;
11. North-east along BALLARD'S BROOK, flowing through the grounds of Wergs Hall, and under Wergs Hall Road, Keepers Lane, Codsall Road, Barnhurst Lane to the Shropshire Union Canal.
